APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

- SPYC Design 2.0- Bryant informed the Commissioners:
 - Internships: SPYC will have priority. Staff Liaison Elise will inform the Commission when the job announcement posts.
 - Scholarship Program: Elise is researching ideas. We will host a community design meeting in the fall.
 - Civic Engagement: SPYC presentation to City Council on 4/16.
- Collection's Drive 2018- Chair Bryant reminded the Commissioners that the bins have to be redesigned, and revamped. He suggested March 20th from 4-6pm to be the date to help decorate the bins. The Commissioners agreed.

- Update to City Council- Chair Bryant informed the Commissioners that the presentation is almost finalized. Commissioner Tino stated that he made some rearrangements to the PowerPoint slides. Staff Liaison Elise is working to review the script. The Commissioners will present to City Council on Monday, April 16th, at 6pm.

NEW BUSINESS

- SPYC Social 2018- Staff Liaison Elise reminded the Commissioners that they voted on having Boba as the beverage of choice for the SPYC Social. She suggested the Commissioners have a vote for the top three flavors in order to reduce complications. The Commission chose two flavors: milk tea and strawberry.
