APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

- Minutes were approved for the regular meeting held on May 3rd, 2018.

PUBLIC COMMENT

- Mr. Hindler- Mr. Hindler congratulated the Commissioners on their presentation to City Council.

SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

- SPYC Design 2.0- Staff Liaison Elise reminded the Commissioners that applied to the summer internship program that they needed to reply to the email, that they received, to select their interview date. More information on the SPYC design meeting will be provided in the coming meetings. Elise reported that she is working with Hysten Consulting to prepare for these meetings.
