#### SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

- SPYC Design 2.0- Staff Liaison Elise has continued to work on the proposed Program Goals 2018-2020.

Goal #1: Internship Program: Staff Liaison Elise informed the Commissioners that

applications are closed and interviews will be set up for later in May. The YSCP team will reach out soon.

Goal #2: Scholarship Concept: Staff Liaison Elise informed the Commissioners that the Scholarship Concept is continuing to work. As mentioned before, the information that was gathered in the Community Meeting will be reviewed by the YSCP team. Elise informed the group that the SPYC will work with YSCP this summer and fall, to begin create a proposal for City Council. By Winter 2020, the goal is to present to City Council.
