City Manager, City of San Pablo

Matt Rodriguez was appointed the San Pablo City Manager on May 3, 2010. The San Pablo City Manager is the chief administrator for the City Municipal Corporation which provides municipal services over the City's 2.4 square miles with approximately 30,000 residents, and nearly 196.8 FTE employees, effective July 1, 2019. He is responsible for implementation of the San Pablo City Council's adopted policies and annual priority workplan, and administers the City's first-ever adopted FY 2018-2021 quadrennial (4-year) general fund operating budget, with \$45.6M in expense appropriations for the FY 2019-20 period.

Mr. Rodriguez previously served as the co-founder, and first Executive Director (2011-18), for the San Pablo Economic Development Corporation (SPEDC), a non-profit, 501 c3 corporation established in March 2011 by the City of San Pablo focused on developing new programs and services geared toward workforce development, job and vocational training, and local business development for the San Pablo community. Recently, the SPEDC served a critical role in the development of major public projects as a Community Development Enterprise (CDE) under the New Market Tax Credit (NMTC) Financing Program, an economic development program through the U.S. Treasury Department.

He has served nearly 29 years in local government managing a multitude of full-service municipal services in various executive management capacities, formerly with the Southern California cities of: Imperial Beach, Los Angeles, Solana Beach, and with the County of Orange, CA. Prior to San Pablo, he served as Assistant and former Deputy City Manager (2005-2010) with the City of Pittsburg, CA in Northern California.

Mr. Rodriguez earned a B.S. Degree in Public Administration, a Master's Degree in Public Administration (MPA), and a Master's Degree in Urban Planning (MPL), from the University of Southern California in Los Angeles, CA. He has also earned a Credentialed City Manager Certification from the International City/County Management Association (ICMA) (2004-2006).
