The San Pablo Police Department, in partnership with the California Highway Patrol and The Richmond Police Department, will be conducting a commercial vehicle checkpoint on Wednesday, November 6th, as a part of The City of San Pablo's commitment to public safety. The checkpoint is one of several checkpoints that will be conducted in the coming months. The checkpoint will be positioned in the area of Goodrick Rd and Parr Blvd between 7:00 am to 11:00 pm. The purpose of the checkpoint is to ensure the safe operation and compliance of Heavy Vehicles with the California Vehicle Code, and to remove dangerous and unsafe vehicles from the roadway.

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), checkpoints have the most effective results of any enforcement strategy, while still yielding considerable cost savings for the public. *Ninety (90) percent of California drivers approve of checkpoints.

The results of the checkpoint will be made public at a later date and time.
