SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

- Staff Liaison Elise has continued to support work on the proposed Program Goals 2018-2020.

- Senior Thanksgiving- Commissioner Lizbeth informed the Commission that on Tuesday, November 19th Commissioners supported the Senior Center Thanksgiving. They helped to serve drinks and desserts, they took pictures, and supported the drawing. Lizbeth informed the Commission that it was a lot of fun.

NEW BUSINESS

- Cleaner Contra Costa Challenge for Youth Summit 2020- Staff Liaison Elise informed the Commissioners that the Officer's recommendation is to create profiles and challenges for middle school, high school, and even school clubs. For the Youth Summit, the Commission could bring everyone together to celebrate their achievements. Commissioners voted to approve of a Cleaner Contra Costa Challenge and Youth Summit.
