

SOLID WASTE SERVICES ALERT

Republic Services has notified the City of San Pablo that due to the outbreak of COVID-19 and for the health and safety of collection vehicle drivers, employees and the community, certain services will be suspended temporarily.

Until further notice, Republic will be operating under the following guidelines:

- Only weekly residential cart/commercial bin contents will be collected.
- Drivers will not be authorized to leave their vehicles to pick up wastes outside carts or commercial containers.
- Starting May 18th, on-call pick-up of bagged materials and bulky household items will resume. Call (510) 262-7100 to schedule a pick-up.

The West County Integrated Resource Recovery Facility (“IRRF”) located at 101 Pittsburg Avenue, Richmond, CA 94801 will be operating under the following guidelines:

- Door-to-door pick-up of Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) for disabled and senior residents will be suspended temporarily.
- The HHW Drop-Off Center will continue regular operating schedule: Wednesday through Saturday, 9:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m. (closed 12:00-1:00 p.m.). Please call 1-(888) 412-9277 for more information. NOTE: The El Cerrito Recycling Center which was accepting HHW on Tuesdays, is temporarily closed.
- The IRRF will continue to accept mattresses (“Bye-bye Mattress” Program) Wednesday through Saturday, 9:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m. (closed 12:00-1:00 p.m.).
- The IRRF Recycling Buy-back Center is temporarily closed.
- The Compost Give-away Program will be temporarily suspended.

The City has also temporarily suspended the Dumpster Day events. However, the City continues to issue Dump Vouchers. Please call (510) 215-3064 to request a Dump Voucher as the building counters are currently closed.

The City and Republic are working hard to keep the community clean and safe, ensure high quality service with minimal service disruption while facing a unique challenge that requires dedicated focus on public health and safety.
