SAN PABLO CITY COUNCIL DECARES LOCAL EMERGENCY AND LAUNCHES MODIFIED CITY OPERATIONS PLAN, EFFECTIVE MARCH 16, 2020

(San Pablo, CA, March 17, 2020) On March 16, 2020, the City of San Pablo City Council declared a state of local emergency by adoption of Resolution No. 2002-034 following the recent shelter-in-place order issued by six (6) Bay Area County Public Health Directors, effective March 17, 2020 until April 7, 2020, due to efforts to contain the novel coronavirus COVID-19 viral outbreak, with duties and powers pursuant to State Government Code section 8558 and 8630, and San Pablo Municipal Code Requirements Section 2.36.

“The local emergency declaration will enable the City to activate its Emergency Operations Center, and transform City Operations to an “essential services” mode of operation with closure of non-essential City facilities, limited public services, and designation of all City employees as local disaster workers in response to the coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic.” stated San Pablo City Manager Matt Rodriguez, acting as the City’s designated Emergency Services Director. **“Our intention is to ensure all County public health protective and preventative measures are instituted for City Operations in order to protect the public, City employees and first responders.”**

The City is also instituting social distancing guidelines for its Modified City Operations Plan with all City facilities closed to the public. Police Department and first responder/patrol services remain a priority service, with other limited City services provided to the public at this time. All Modified City Operations will be subject to guidelines and directives from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, State of California, and local County Public Health Officer issued to date.

The City will continue to assess City Operations and services on a daily basis prior to the April 7, 2020 pursuant to the shelter-in-place order issued yesterday by Bay Area County Public Health Directors. All City Business is encouraged by email, on-line and phone with the public until further notice.

AYUNTAMIENTO DE SAN PABLO DECLARA EMERGENCIA LOCAL Y LANZA EL PLAN MODIFICADO DE OPERACIONES EN LA CIUDAD, VIGENTE EL 16 DE MARZO DE 2020

(San Pablo, CA, 17 de marzo de 2020) El 16 de marzo de 2020, el Concejo Municipal de la Ciudad de San Pablo declaró un estado de emergencia local mediante la adopción de la Resolución No. 2002-034 tras la reciente orden-de-refugio emitida por seis (6) Directores de Salud Pública del Condado del Área de la Bahía, en vigencia desde el 17 de marzo de 2020 hasta el 7 de abril de 2020, debido a los esfuerzos para contener el nuevo brote viral del coronavirus COVID-19, con deberes y poderes de conformidad con las secciones 8558 y 8630 del Código de Gobierno del Estado, y los Requisitos del Código Municipal de San Pablo, Sección 2.36.

"La declaración de emergencia local permitirá a la Ciudad activar su Centro de Operaciones de Emergencia y transformar las Operaciones de la Ciudad en un modo de operación de "servicios esenciales" con el cierre de instalaciones no esenciales de la Ciudad, servicios públicos limitados y la designación de todos los empleados de la Ciudad como trabajadores de desastres locales en respuesta a la pandemia de coronavirus COVID-19. " declaró el Gerente Municipal de San Pablo, Matt Rodríguez, actuando como el Director de Servicios de Emergencia designado de la ciudad. "Nuestra intención es garantizar que todas las medidas preventivas y protectoras de salud pública del condado se instituyan en las operaciones de la ciudad con el fin de proteger al público, a los empleados de la ciudad y personal de auxilio".

La Ciudad también está instituyendo normas de distanciamiento social para su Plan de Operaciones de la Ciudad Modificado con todas las instalaciones de la Ciudad cerradas al público. El Departamento de Policía y los servicios de primera respuesta/patrulla siguen siendo un servicio prioritario, con otros servicios limitados de la Ciudad proporcionados al público en este momento. Todas las operaciones municipales modificadas estarán sujetas a las normas y directivas de los Centros para el Control y la Prevención de Enfermedades, el Estado de California y el Oficial de Salud Pública del Condado local emitido hasta la fecha.

La Ciudad continuará evaluando las Operaciones y los servicios de la Ciudad diariamente antes del 7 de abril de 2020 de conformidad con la orden-de-refugio emitida ayer por los Directores de Salud Pública del Condado de Bay Area. CORONAVIRUS COVID-19 UPDATE AND MODIFIED CITY OPERATIONS PLAN – REVISION/UPDATE (Version #7; 06/04/20)

Please be advised the City Manager, acting as the City's Emergency Services Director, is providing this authorization pursuant to San Pablo Municipal Code Chapter 2.36 and the City's ongoing Declaration of an Emergency (City Council Resolutions #2020-034; #2020-042; #2020-051; #2020-055; #2020-060, and #2020-068).

CITY ESSENTIAL BUSINESS/CITY PROJECT UPDATES

Pursuant to new requirements issued by the Contra Costa County Public Health Officer since March 16, 2020, the Modified City Operations Plans dated March 16, 2020, March 19, 2020, April 1, 2020, April 8, 2020, April 20, 2020, April 29, 2020, May 15, 2020, and May 18, 2020 are still in effect to the extent not superseded by a subsequent Modified Operations Plan (MOP).

• GENERAL INFORMATION:

❖ **County Department oHealth Shelter-In-Place Order**

The County Order No. #HO-COVID19-16 (Extended Shelter-In-Place Order) went into effect at **6:00 a.m. on June 3, 2020**, supersedes the previous Orders, and hereby extends the Shelter-In-Place indefinitely while allowing certain businesses and activities under certain conditions. (See Attached CCCHS Order No. #HO-COVID19-16 issued on June 2, 2020)

❖ **Contra Costa County-wide Curfew:**

- **All City Administrative Offices who have Essential Services staff working in City Departments shall vacate all City Administrative Offices by 5:00p.m each business day while County-wide Curfew is in effect.** Once County-wide Curfew is rescinded, then regular City Normal Business Hours may resume for essential, limited City personnel unless the City's Emergency Services Director declares a Local Emergency Due to Civil Unrest and City-wide curfew with more restrictive requirements.

General guidance:

• **NEW COVID-19 WORKPLACE POLICIES FOR CITY DEPARTMENTS:**

City Administration/Human Resources staff have developed three (3) new policies for review and implementation for all City Departments and employees which will go into effect on Monday June 8, 2020, as follows:

1. **COVID-19 Employee Health Screenings**
2. **COVID-19 Protocols for Social Distancing – COVID19 Response Plan**
3. **Expectations of Employees Returning to Work**

All COVID-19 workplace policies have been developed in accordance with Center for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines, and the California Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1973 to assure safe and healthy working conditions for all City workers. (Labor Code § 6300, et seq.) **Strict adherence to these workplace guidelines and protection measures must be followed by all City Departments and employees, effective June 8, 2020.**

• **ALL CITY DEPARTMENTS: (ALL CITY DEPARTMENTS REMAIN IN ESSENTIAL SERVICES FUNCTIONS PER CURRENT CCCHS ORDER NO. #HO-COVID-19-16 IN EFFECT ON JUNE 2, 2020 UNLESS NOTED BELOW)**

❖ **Civic Center Public Access/Building #3; Permit Center**

Access gates into the current Civic Center Plaza will NOT be **OPEN** for public access until further notice.

❖ **City Drop-Off Box for Building #3/Permit Center:**

A City drop-off box for City related business/documents for Civic Center Building #3/Permit Center will be located out front of Civic Center access gates, effective May 4, 2020. For larger plan review, drop-off coordination can be made with City Building #3 staff by contacting (510) 215-3030 in advance. **City Drop-off box hours are Monday-Thursday, from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. The Civic Center Building #3/Permit Center remains closed to the general public until further notice.**

No other public access to City Administrative Offices will be permitted, unless the necessity of an appointment is approved by the Department Head. All social distancing protocols and face covering requirements per the CCCHS Order No. #HO-COVID19-16 in effect, and City adopted policies noted above.

• POLICE DEPARTMENT LOBBY

- ❖ **Public Visitors:** As of June 8, 2020, the following protocols will be in place for visitors or those seeking services at the Police Department Facility located at 13880 San Pablo Avenue, San Pablo. The essential nature of public safety work and the possibility of rapid and extension contamination of an entire shift of public safety officers – and possibly community contamination -- if one contaminated person enters the Police Department facility mandates more extensive but non-invasive screening and distancing precautions. Despite these precautions mandated by the COVID-19 pandemic, it remains the Department's mission to serve the community; although, the modes of communication may differ now.
 - A. The public is encouraged to view the City's website <https://sanpabloca.gov/187/Police-Department> or to contact the Department at 510-215-3130 to determine if questions or requests can be handled online or by phone first.
 - B. If someone cannot resolve a matter online or by phone, there is an intercom system outside the lobby at the Police Facility at 13880 San Pablo Avenue. No one will be able to enter the Lobby without calling from that phone/intercom system. Cleaning supplies will be located by the intercom so members of the public can clean the buttons before using them.
 - C. Once contacting the Lobby staff, the person will be directed to wait in their car or at a marked off location at least 6 feet away from the Lobby doors as indicated by a sign until allowed into the Lobby.
 - D. Anyone entering the Police Department Lobby must:
 - 1. Wear a mask covering their mouth and nose.
 - 2. Not be living with someone or in close contact with someone who has COVID-19 or is under quarantine for suspected COVID-19 infection.
 - 3. Be free of the following symptoms:
 - a. Fever
 - b. Dry Cough
 - c. Shortness of breath
 - 4. Police Department staff will ask persons before entering the Police Department Lobby if they meet the criteria in Section D. If the person has been exposed to COVID-19 per subsection 2 above or appears to have any of the symptoms listed in subsection 3 above, then Police Department staff will not allow the person into the Police Department Lobby and will attempt to provide assistance remotely. All such interactions will be reported to the On-Duty Supervisor to determine if any follow-up is needed. Information on COVID-19 free testing occurring at the West Contra Costa Health Facility located nearby at 13601 San Pablo Avenue, San Pablo will be made available.

- E. **LiveScan/FingerPrinting Services:** For anyone desiring or needing Livescan/fingerprinting services, which require close physical contact, in addition to the requirements in Section (D), consent will be asked to take that person's temperature by non-invasive thermometer scan.
1. The person's temperature will be taken prior to entering the building.
 2. If the person's temperature is 100.4 degrees or higher, then the person will be asked to wait outside in the shade away from the Lobby doors for 2 minutes and then the temperature will be retaken.
 3. If the person's temperature remains above 100.4 degrees, then the person will be provided information (English/Spanish available) on COVID-19 testing occurring at: 1) Lifelong Medical Care, Inc., located at 2023 Vale Road, San Pablo; or 2) West Contra Costa Health Facility, located at 13601 San Pablo Avenue, San Pablo.
 4. If the person refuses to consent to the thermometer scan, then they will be provided alternate Live Scan sites, if applicable, or rescheduled.

The City's Essential Services/Governmental Functions under the Revised Modified Operations Plan are still in effect until such time that the Shelter-In-Place orders have expired, have been extended by CCCHS Officials, and/or have been further revised by the City Manager/Emergency Services Director.

NEW CITY HALL PROJECT



The City is currently constructing a new 42,000 square foot two-story City Hall at the corner of Gateway Avenue and Chattleton Lane. The new building will be LEED Silver Positive and will provide for a more efficient work space and room for the City's growing workforce. Construction on the New San Pablo City Hall is progressing with external and interior painting underway for completion by mid-November 2019 subject to rain delays. Overall, construction is scheduled for completion in **early July 2020**.

CONSTRUCTION THIS WEEK

The City has deemed this project an "Essential Government Function/Essential Public Works Project" pursuant to the Contra Costa County Health Services Order No.#HO-COVID19-03 issued 03/31/20 (Section 13.f.v.#4), and Order No. #HO-COVID19-09 issued 04/29/20 (Section 16.c.f.#5). The City's current City Hall does not meet the Federal Americans with Disabilities Act and State accessibility requirements, as well as other Building Code requirements. The project is near completion. This remains an active construction project with construction activity/progress through May 31, 2020, and extended until further notice.

Proyecto de el Nuevo Ayuntamiento de La Ciudad

Actualmente, la Ciudad está construyendo un nuevo Ayuntamiento de dos pisos y 42,000 pies cuadrados en la esquina de Gateway Avenue y Chattleton Lane. El nuevo edificio será LEED Silver y proporcionará un espacio de trabajo más eficiente y espacio para la creciente fuerza laboral de la Ciudad. La construcción en el nuevo ayuntamiento de San Pablo sigue progresando con la pintura del exterior e interior que se completará para los mediados de noviembre 2019 conforme a las demoras de la lluvia. En general, la construcción está programada para completarse a principios de 2020.

El proyecto está en sus últimas etapas. Este sigue siendo un proyecto de construcción activo con actividad / progreso de construcción hasta el 31 de mayo de 2020 y extendida hasta nuevo aviso.

NEW FIRE STATION 70



The City and the Contra Costa County Fire Protection District are currently constructing a new, state-of-the-art Fire Station 70 at the corner of Market and 23rd Streets which will replace the current fire station located on San Pablo Avenue. The new location will be more central to the City and will provide for better response times. Construction is ongoing and scheduled for completion in December 2020.

CONSTRUCTION THIS WEEK

The Contra Costa County/Contra Costa County Fire Protection District has deemed this project an "Essential Government Function/Essential Public Works Project" pursuant to the Contra Costa County Health Services Order No.#HO-COVID19-03 issued 03/31/20 (Section 13.f.v.#4). and Order No.#HO-COVID19-09 issued 04/29/20 (Section 16.c.f.#5). Current fire and paramedic services in San Pablo are currently housed in portable buildings that do not meet needs and requirements. This remains an active construction project with construction activity/progress. Window work will begin this week on the building exterior. In the interior, "rough ins" at the first floor is almost completed. Posts for the site wall are being erected along the site perimeter.

La Ciudad y el Distrito de Protección de Incendios del Condado de Contra Costa están construyendo una nueva Estación de Bomberos 70 con instalaciones-avanzadas en la esquina de las calles Market y 23 que reemplazará a la actual estación de bomberos ubicada en la Avenida San Pablo. El Condado de Contra Costa/El Distrito de Protección Contra Incendios del Condado de Contra Costa ha considerado este proyecto como una "Función esencial del gobierno / Proyecto de obras públicas esenciales" de conformidad con la Orden de Servicios de Salud del Condado de Contra Costa No. # HO-COVID19-03 emitida el 03/31/20 (Sección 13.fv4) y Orden#HO-COVID19-09 emitida 04/29/20 (Section 16.c.f.#5). Los servicios actuales de bomberos y paramédicos en San Pablo se encuentran actualmente en edificios portátiles que no satisfacen las necesidades y requisitos. Este sigue siendo un proyecto de construcción activo con actividad / progreso de construcción. Esta semana comenzarán los trabajos en las ventanas del exterior del edificio. WILDCAT CREEK RESTORATION & GREENWAY TRAIL PROJECT

The Wildcat Creek Restoration and Greenway Trail project construction bids were advertised in November 2019 and City Council awarded the project to the lowest responsive bidder, Ghilotti Construction, in January 2020. Construction for the project will begin in late February and is anticipated to be completed by the end of 2020. Some tree removal and parking lot improvements will begin in spring 2020 while the creek restoration or majority of the construction work will start in the summer or dry season.

CONSTRUCTION THIS WEEK

The City's project contractor has completed their work on the parking lot, finishing Phase I of the project. The City's contractor will now begin with Phase II of the project involving creek trail segment. The contractor plans to begin clearing and grubbing along the creek next week. This operation will make way for the grading of the creek bank.



Las licitaciones para la construcción del proyecto Restauración del Arroyo Wildcat e Instalación de Sendero Verde se anunciaron en noviembre de 2019 y el Ayuntamiento

otorgó el proyecto al licitador con oferta más baja, Ghilotti Construction, en enero de 2020. La construcción del proyecto comenzará a fines de febrero y se espera completar para fines de 2020. PUBLIC FIBER WIDE AREA NETWORK (WAN) PROJECT

Construction of the City's first-ever public fiber wide area network (WAN) communications system is underway, and will connect the various City facilities together in one uniform fiber network to address critical infrastructure needs of the current system, including improved reliability, speed, resiliency, and security.

The City has recognized that this public fiber project could be leveraged to further the City Council's goal of providing high-speed fiber optic or wireless connectivity to businesses and residents across the City. Initially, the current San Pablo Fiber Wide Area Network (WAN) Project aims to connect several City facilities via a fiber optic line.



CONSTRUCTION THIS WEEK

In compliance with Appendix B-2 of Contra Costa County Health Order No. #HOCOV19-09 issued April 29 (Section 16.f.v), this work will resume on May 26, 2020. The City's contractor will continue to pull the fiber from new City Hall to Police Dept Building. Afterward, they will test the connectivity of each fiber. Next week, the contractor plans to remobilize at Road 20 and begin their directional boring operation along this extent.

Proyecto (WAN) De Red Pública De Fibra Amplia

La construcción del primer sistema público de comunicaciones de red de fibra amplia (WAN) de la Ciudad está en marcha, y conectará las diversas instalaciones municipales de la ciudad en una sola red de fibra para atender las necesidades críticas de infraestructura del sistema actual, incluyendo la mejora de la confiabilidad, la velocidad, la resiliencia y la seguridad.

La ciudad ha reconocido que este proyecto de fibra pública podría ser aprovechado para promover conectividad de fibra óptica o inalámbrica de alta velocidad a las empresas y residentes en toda la ciudad. 

El Portal Drive Urban Greening Project



El Portal Drive Urban Greening Project is a state and locally funded multi-benefit project to on the segment of El Portal Drive between Church

Lane and Fordham Street. The project will include a linear bioretention facility to capture and clean a portion of the stormwater that falls on the southern section of El Portal Drive, complete with educational interpretive signs. A Class IV bike lane on the southern, eastbound side of El Portal Drive, will be separated and protected from the roadway by the bioretention facility and other physical safety barriers. A Class II bike lane on the northern, westbound side of El Portal Drive, will consist of striping and extra space between the bike lane and the roadway.

CONSTRUCTION THIS WEEK

In compliance with Appendix B-2 of Contra Costa County Health Order No. #HOCOV19-09 issued April 29 (Section 16.f.v), this work will start on May 26, 2020. A temporary detour will be implemented later this week when the contractor will pour the remaining retaining curb along El Portal. Flagmen will be available to direct motorists to the detour route, as necessary.

El Proyecto de Greening Urbano de El Portal Drive es un proyecto de beneficios múltiples financiado por el estado y localmente en el segmento de El Portal Drive entre Church Lane y Fordham Street.
