Trash Cleanup Safety Guidelines:

Due to the COVID-19 health crisis, the City will not be coordinating the cleanup as a City event. Please follow these safety guidelines:

- Wear your mask and follow social-distancing guidelines
- Pick up items with gloves or tongs only
- Do not enter the creek
- Stay with your group
- Do not touch or pick up sharp objects
- Be respectful of private property
- Leave heavy objects behind. Contact the City to remove large items: 1-800-NO-DUMPING
- Stay on sidewalks and pedestrian paths
- Take trash home or to a City trash can for disposal
