Free Waste Disposal Options



Leaving trash on the street, sidewalk, or other public place is against the law and subject to fines.

Dump Voucher Program

- ◆ San Pablo residents are eligible to receive \$60 worth of dump vouchers per fiscal year (July 1st through June 30th).
- ◆ Vouchers can be picked up at City Hall (1000 Gateway Avenue). Personal ID and a current utility bill are required.
- ◆ The vouchers can be credited toward disposal at the Golden Bear Transfer Station (1 Parr Blvd, Richmond).

Waste Drop Off

- ◆ San Pablo residents can bring their trash to 2600 Moraga Rd, San Pablo on certain Saturdays for free disposal from 7AM until dumpsters are full.
- ◆ Call the Maintenance Division at (510) 215-3070 for the date of the next event.
- ◆ Personal ID and a current utility bill are required. Limit of 1 trip per address. Hazardous materials, mattresses and tires not accepted.

Curbside Cleanup Collection

- ◆ Single family and duplex households are entitled to 2 curbside collections per year of up to 15 bags (35-40 gallons) per collection.
- ◆ Miscellaneous and landscaping/green waste only. Hazardous wastes are not accepted.
- ◆ To schedule a pick-up, please call Republic Services at (510) 262-7100.

Curbside Bulky Item Collection

- ◆ Single family and duplex households are entitled to 1 curbside collection per year of 1 large item (e.g. furniture).
- ◆ Construction, demolition and hazardous wastes are not accepted.
- ◆ To schedule a pick-up, please call Republic Services at (510) 262-7100.

Household Hazardous Waste

- ◆ Residents can bring household hazardous waste to 101 Pittsburg Ave, Richmond (510-412-4500) for free disposal.
- ◆ Eligible items include electronics, oil (cooking & car), batteries, lightbulbs, chemicals, paint, etc.
- ◆ Drop off hours are 9AM—4PM (closed 12PM - 12:30PM), Wednesday through Saturday.

Mattress Recycling

- ◆ Residents can bring old mattresses or box springs to 101 Pittsburg Ave, Richmond (510-412-4500) for free disposal.
- ◆ Personal ID and a current utility bill are required. Maximum 3 items per month.
- ◆ Drop off hours are 9AM—4PM (closed 12PM - 12:30PM), Wednesday through Saturday.
