

## RESOLUTION 2021-089

### RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 2021-23 ADOPTED CITY COUNCIL PRIORITY WORKPLAN UNDER MAJOR POLICY GOAL: IMPROVE PUBLIC SAFETY TO ADD NEW POLICY ITEM TO EXPLORE FEASIBILITY OF AMENDING SAN PABLO MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCREASE ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS AGAINST THE USE OF ILLEGAL FIREWORKS TO MINIMIZE IMPACTS TO PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2021, the City Council rescinded previous adopted Resolution 2021-018, and adopted Resolution No. #2021-026, which amended the FY 2021-23 City Council Priority Workplan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may periodically amend the FY 2021-23 City Council Priority Workplan (Workplan) to add or eliminate policies by majority vote via adopted Resolution; and direct the City Manager on policy and/or program implementation; and

WHEREAS, at the June 7, 2021 City Council meeting, on motion made by Vice Mayor Xavier, duly seconded, the City Council authorized by majority vote to agendaize a policy discussion at the June 21, 2021 City Council meeting to consider amending the adopted FY 2021-23 Council Priority Workplan (Workplan); and

WHEREAS, following City Council discussion, the City Council desires to formalize this amendment to the Workplan by said Resolution attached hereto, and to direct the City Manager to conduct additional policy research and/or develop specific policy recommendations related to this adopted policy amendment for subsequent formal discussion and approval by the City Council in the near future.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City Council of the City of San Pablo authorizes the following, as follows:

1. **Proposed Workplan Policy Amendment for City Council Discussion:**

**MAJOR POLICY AREA: IMPROVE PUBLIC SAFETY**

**Add/New: Policy Item #514:**

***Explore feasibility of amending SPMC (via Ordinance) to increase enforcement actions (with feasible options) against the use of illegal fireworks to minimize impacts to public health and safety.***
