


Bay Area Stormwater Requirements for Construction Projects¹ (effective July, 1, 2023)

Project Impervious Area = new/replaced impervious area* (e.g. roof, garage, concrete or asphalt surface) + disturbed soil area.

*This also includes any impervious public rights-of-way (i.e. sidewalk or roadway) that are required to be updated, added, or replaced.

Note: Impervious surfaces do not let water drain through. Disturbed soil areas include anywhere digging goes below concrete or asphalt.



C.3 Regulated Projects

- The National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) regulates stormwater discharge across the U.S. The San Francisco Bay Area is regulated by NPDES through the Municipal Regional Permit (MRP). The above requirements are summarized from the MRP 3.0, approved in 2022. See the most recent edition of the [Contra Costa Clean Water Program \(CCCWP\) Stormwater C.3 Guidebook](#) for more details.
