**Subject:** Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) Zone Information

As a public service, the City of San Pablo will provide you with the following information upon request:

- (1) Whether a property is in or out of the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA), as shown on the current Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) for the City of San Pablo, which can also be accessed at: <https://msc.fema.gov/portal/home>.
- (2) Additional flood insurance data for a site, such as the FIRM Zone, the Base Flood Elevation (BFE) or depth, if shown on the FIRM.
- (3) Handout or link on the mandatory flood insurance purchase requirement that applies to those who are getting a federally-backed mortgage or loan for a property in the SFHA.
- (4) Access to Elevation Certificates that have been processed in the City of San Pablo Building Division, if they exist, for a certain property.
- (5) Information about flood problems other than those shown on the FIRM.
- (6) Information about flood depths, special flood-related hazards such as erosion, past flooding at or near the site in question, and areas that should be protected because of their natural floodplain functions.
