



## **MEET THE CITY MANAGER**

### **Matt Rodriguez, City Manager**

Matt Rodriguez was appointed the San Pablo City Manager on May 3, 2010.

#### **DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES**

The San Pablo City Manager is the chief administrative officer for the City Municipal Corporation which provides municipal services over the City's 2.4 square miles with approximately 31,000 residents, and nearly 200 FTE employees, effective July 1, 2024. The City Manager reports directly to a 5-member elected City Council who appoints a Mayor and Vice-mayor annually and is responsible for implementation of City Council's adopted policies contained in the Council's annual priority workplan. As City Manager, he is responsible for the development of the City's two-year biennial general fund operating budget, with \$54.3M and \$56.3M in adopted expense appropriations for the FY 2024-2026 period.

From 2011-2018, Mr. Rodriguez served concurrently as the Executive Director for the San Pablo Economic Development Corporation (SPEDC), a non-profit, 501 c3 corporation established in March 2011 focused on developing new programs and services geared toward workforce development, job and vocational training, housing, and local business development for the San Pablo community.

#### **PREVIOUS MUNICIPAL EXPERIENCE**

Rodriguez has served nearly 35 years in local government managing a multitude of full-service municipal services in a number of ascending, executive management positions formerly with the Southern California cities of: City of Los Angeles (1990-1991), County of Orange (1992-1996), City of Imperial Beach (1996-2002), City of Solana Beach (2002-2005). Most recently, prior to his appointment in San Pablo, Rodriguez served as the former Assistant City Manager and Deputy City Manager/External Services with the City of Pittsburg, CA (2005-2010) in Northern California.

#### **EDUCATION AND PROFESSIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS**

Rodriguez earned a B.S. Degree in Public Administration (1992), a Master's Degree in Public Administration (1995), and a Master's Degree in Urban Planning (1995), from the University of Southern California in Los Angeles, CA. He is also a graduate of the Local Government Summer Institute Program at Stanford University (October 2021), and a graduate of the Senior Executives in State and Local Government Program at Harvard University's John F. Kennedy School of Government (July 2022). Additionally, Rodriguez earned an Executive Certificate in Public Leadership from Harvard University's John F. Kennedy School of Government in January 2024, and became a Credentialed City Manager from the International City/County Management Association (ICMA-CM) from 2004-2006, and most recently in January 2025 to date.
