## Free Home Pickup

For Single and Multi-Family Dwellings

### CURBSIDE BULKY ITEM PICKUP

3 bulky curbside collections per year  
Choose of one of the following options:

1 large item  
Examples: furniture, rugs, household appliance

5 e-waste items  
Examples: computer, TV, monitor, printer

Call Republic Services to schedule a pick-up (510) 262-7100  
No Construction, demolition and hazardous waste accepted

Up to 15 bags (bag size: 35 gallon) of miscellaneous home or yard waste

Up to 4 bags (bag size: 95 gallon) of miscellaneous home or yard waste

Tenants of multi-family dwellings cannot schedule bulky item pickups. Contact your property manager to discuss this service.

### DUMP VOUCHER PROGRAM

May use once per fiscal year (July 1-June 30)

Free voucher worth \$120

Bring ID & utility bill to City Hall-Public Works Dept.  
1000 Gateway Avenue, 2nd floor, Mon-Th 7:30a-4p

Voucher credited towards waste disposal at the Golden Bear Transfer Station (1 Parr Blvd., Richmond)

Personal vehicle with up to 2 cubic yards of home or yard waste

Bring ID and utility bill to show proof of San Pablo residency

For Residents of West County & San Pablo

### HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Free disposal of up to 15 gallons or 125 pounds of electronics, oil, paint, batteries, etc.

### FREE MATTRESS RECYCLING

3 items per month at no cost  
Example: Mattress, Box Spring, Futon



Bring ID or current utility bill to show proof of residency, & items to facility

For Residents of West County & San Pablo

Up to 2 cubic yards of free compost material per month

This is self-service only, so please bring a shovel and your own bag, bin, or bucket to load the material
