A few businesses have asked what they should do with their existing plastic foam (Styrofoam™) inventory. Since the City of San Pablo is dedicated to reducing the amount of waste heading to the landfill, please do not throw your left over inventory in the trash.

We recommend the following options:

1. Return plastic foam products to your Distributor or Manufacturer. Let them know these items are NOT compliant with the Plastic Foam Ordinance and ask them to stock only Compostable or Recycled products.
2. If your business is part of a chain store, return or sell the plastic foam product to the corporate office for use in other stores not impacted with a similar Ordinance.
3. Donate plastic foam food ware to food banks or shelters.
